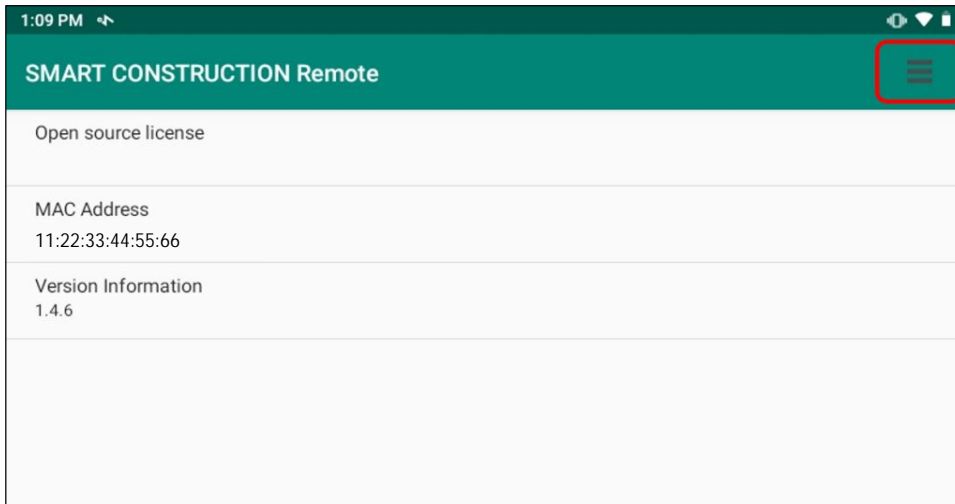
MAC Address Output Method

Preconditions

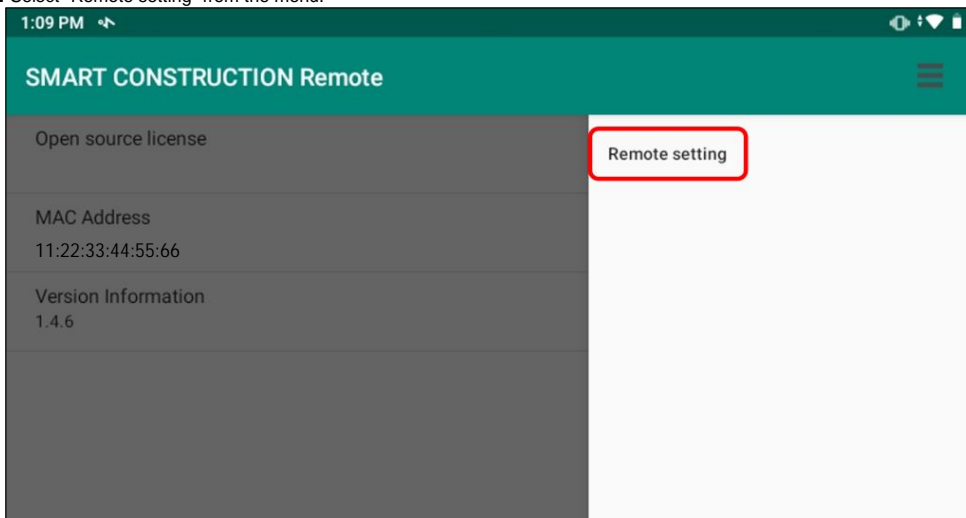
1. The Panel Agent must be started (there must be no diagonal lines on the Constant Monitor icon).

MAC address output

- 1 Start the Panel Agent and tap the Hamburger menu.



- 2 Select "Remote setting" from the menu.

Details on respective items of Remote setting

Machine Model Name, Model Number	Model number	Required	Entries possible with single byte alphanumeric characters and symbols (excluding symbols that cannot be used for file names) *1, *2
Serial number	Serial No.	Required	Single byte numbers only
Distributer Name	Distributor name	Optional	Entries possible with single byte alphanumeric characters, symbols and spaces *1
Mail address	Destination email address	Required	Only characters that can be used for email addresses *3, *4, *5
Description	Remarks	Optional	Entries possible with single byte alphanumeric characters, symbols, spaces and line feed *1

*1: Following symbols can be used:

! " # \$ % & ' () * + , - . / : ; < = > ? @ [\] ^ _ ` { | } ~

*2: Entries not possible for "Machine Model Name, Model Number" with following symbols, as they cannot be used for file names:

\ / : * ? " < > |

*3: Characters that can be used for email addresses are shown below:

Local portion

Only symbols and alphanumeric characters that are shown below, can be used:

! " # \$ % & ' * + / = ? ^ _ ` { | } ~ -

These cannot be used, however, in following cases:

When the leading character is "." or "-".

When "." precedes "@".

When "." is repeated.

Domain portion

Only symbols and alphanumeric characters that are shown below, can be used:

These cannot be used, however, in following cases:

When not even a single "." is included.

When "@", ".", and "-" are entered in succession.

*4: When multiple destination email addresses are specified, they must be separated using commas (,), single byte spaces () or semicolons (;) (separating characters may be mixed or duplicated).

Example) example1@domain.com, example2@domain.com, ;; example3@domain.com

*5: Refer to " Information on Pasting Email Addresses" when entered values are underlined.

Information on Pasting Email Addresses

Pasting the "Mail Address" while retaining the format of the original document (html format) will lead to the single byte spaces being converted into non-break spaces () and result in an error.



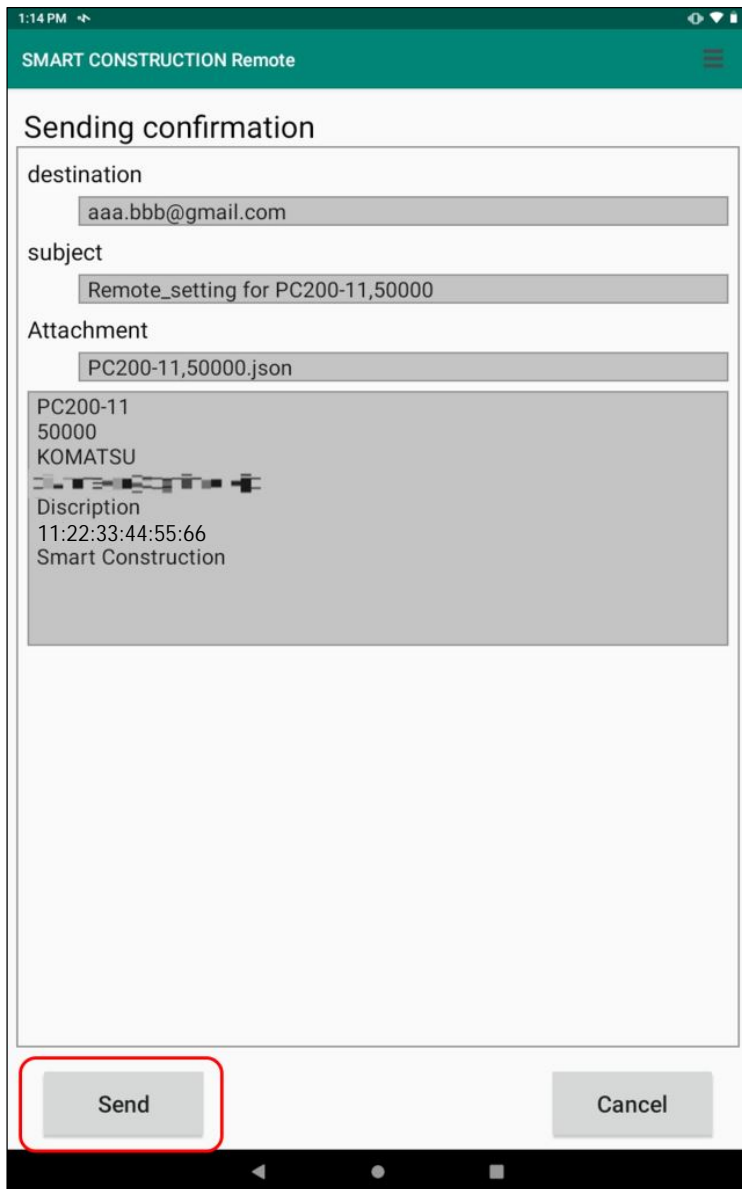
* Example of retained original document format (email address underlined as shown in the figure above).

In such instances, it is necessary to either manually enter the separating character or "paste as unformatted text".

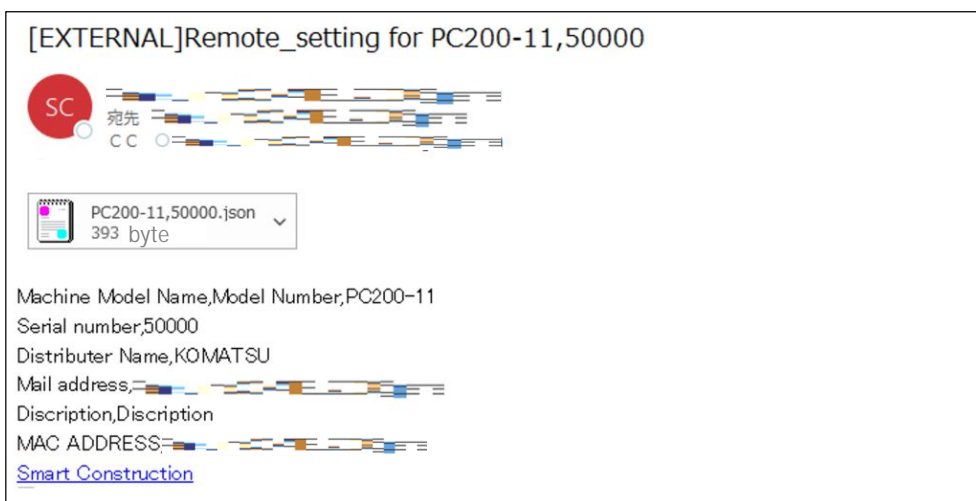


* Example of unretained original document format (email address not underlined as shown in the figure above).

5 Transition to the "Sending confirmation" screen and verify entered information, then tap "Send".



6 The "Sending confirmation" screen closes and an email is sent to deliver entered information to the entered email address.
* The image of the received email shown below is in the html format and an email in the text format will be displayed in a different manner.
