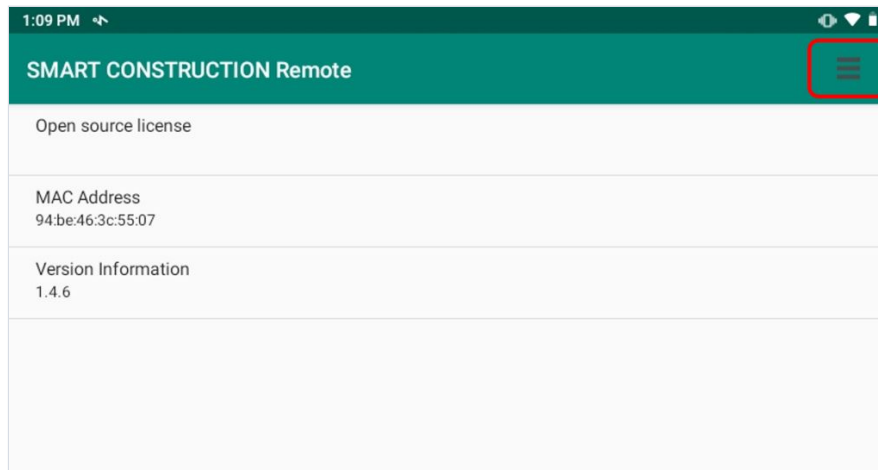

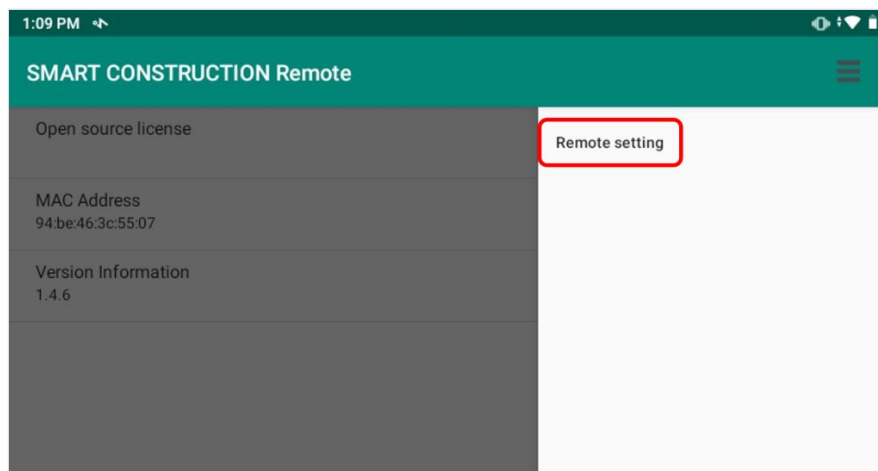
[Android] How to obtain the Device ID

Outputting the Device ID

- 1 Start **SMART CONSTRUCTION Remote** and tap the **hamburger menu**.



- 2 From the menu, select "**Remote setting**".



3 The **"Remote setting"** screen is displayed.

Details of each Remote setting item

Item	On-screen label	Required / Optional	Allowed characters
Machine model name, model number	Machine Model Name, Model Number	Required	Single-byte alphanumeric characters and symbols (excluding symbols not allowed in file names) *1, *2
Serial number	Serial number	Required	Single-byte digits only
Distributor name	Distributor Name	Optional	Single-byte alphanumeric characters, symbols and spaces *1
Email address	Mail address	Required	Only characters allowed in email addresses *3, *4, *5
Description	Description	Optional	Single-byte alphanumeric characters, symbols, spaces and line breaks *1

***1:** The following symbols can be used:

! " # \$ % & ' () * + , - . / : ; < = > ? @ [\] ^ _ ` { | } ~

***2:** For "Machine model name, model number", the following symbols cannot be entered because they are not allowed in file names:

\ / : * ? " < > |

***3:** The characters allowed in email addresses are as follows.

Local part: Only the following symbols and alphanumeric characters can be used:

. ! # \$ % & ' * + / = ? ^ _ ` { | } ~ -

However, they cannot be used in the following cases:

- When the first character is "." or "-".
- When "." immediately precedes "@".
- When "." appears consecutively.

Domain part: Only the following symbols and alphanumeric characters can be used:

- .

However, they cannot be used in the following cases:

- When not even a single "." is included.
- When "@", "-." and "." are entered consecutively.

***4:** When specifying multiple destination email addresses, separate them with a comma (,), a single-byte space () or a semicolon (;) (the separators may be mixed or repeated).

e.g.) example1@domain.com, example2@domain.com, ;; example3@domain.com

***5:** If an entered value is underlined, refer to "Notes on pasting email addresses" below.

Notes on pasting email addresses

Caution: If you paste the "Mail address" while keeping the original document's formatting (HTML format), single-byte spaces are converted to non-breaking spaces () and cause an error.

In that case, you must enter the separator characters manually or use **"paste as plain text"**.

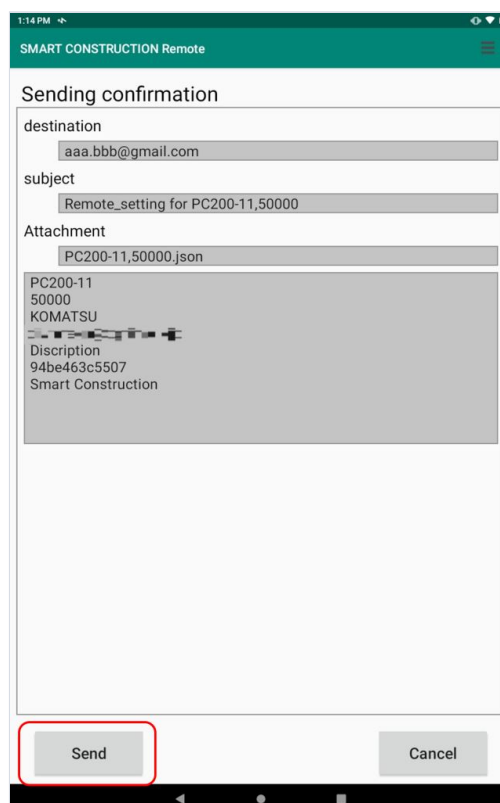

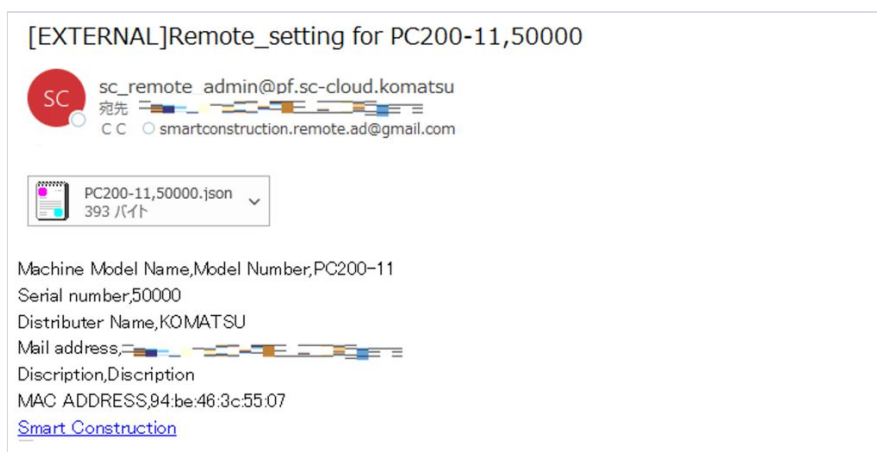
